

Coastal Flood Warning

IMPACTS:

- The Nome-Council road east of Cape Nome may wash out.
- The area around the Belmont Subdivision and the port will be inundated.
- Water from wave run up will likely wash up on Front St.
 - Water may approach the west end of the airport and terminal area
- Wind damage to structures and power outages possible

What to Expect:

Water levels: 8-11 feet above the normal highest tide line

<u>Timing:</u> The highest water levels will occur during this afternoon and continue through early morning Sunday.


Winds: South winds 40 to 50 mph with gusts up to 80 mph possible.






Red is the anticipated area of inundation for water levels of 11ft above the normal highest tide line. This does not account for wave run-up.
